## **HOUSE BILL 1868**

## By Vaughan

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 2, relative to instant runoff voting.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 2, Chapter 8, is amended by adding the following new section:

- (a) As used in this section:
- (1) "Instant runoff voting" and "ranked choice voting" mean a method of casting and tabulating votes in which:
  - (A) Voters rank candidates in order of preference;
  - (B) Tabulation proceeds in rounds such that in each round either a candidate or candidates are elected or the last-place candidate is defeated;
  - (C) Votes are transferred from elected or defeated candidates to the voters' next-ranked candidate or candidates in order of preference; and
  - (D) Tabulation ends when a candidate receives the majority of votes cast or the number of candidates elected equals the number of offices to be filled, as applicable; and
- (2) "Local government" means an incorporated city or town, a county, a metropolitan form of government, a school, utility, or other regional or local district, or a unit of government that is governed by one (1) or more elected officials.

(b) A county election commission shall not utilize instant runoff voting or ranked choice voting to conduct an election in this state for a statewide or local government office.

SECTION 2. This act takes effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
